Two Earn Eagle Scout Awards

The Oakdale City Council recognized Brandon Furch and Thomas Indykiewicz at its Nov. 9 meeting for achieving the rank of Eagle Scout with the Boy Scouts of America.

Mayor Carmen Sarrack presented the Scouts with certificates of achievement in recognition of their work in the community through their service projects.

To complete his Eagle Scout Service Project, Furch upgraded the archery range at Northdale Park located off Granada Avenue at 53rd Street. With the help of volunteers and the assistance of the city parks crew, the updated range now offers new walkways, arrow and bow rests, target bases and a new style of bales.

For his project, Indykiewicz constructed and installed three bat houses in the Oakdale Nature Preserve. He also constructed a prototype bat house display at the Discovery Center at 4444 Hadley Ave. N.

Only 4 percent of the Boy Scouts in the country earn the Eagle Scout award.

Mayor Carmen Sarrack, thanked the boys for their service.

"Both of their projects have significantly added to the quality of life that we all enjoy in Oakdale," Sarrack said.
